

**Bank Wire and CMO (Commercial Money Order)  
SECURE AUTHORIZATION FORM**

To help prevent fraud from Identity Theft, our Insurance Company now **REQUIRES** that we implement additional security procedures for Commercial Money Orders through Western Union (CMOs) and/or Bank Wires. To be in compliance, we need a written, signed agreement authorizing a secure password before these types of funds transfers can be made. This will be used when you are not here in the office.

Be sure to send back this completed and signed form immediately if you plan to transfer funds to family members, bank accounts, mortgage payments, loan payments, etc. through these services. Please use the address below:

If you request a funds transfer before we receive the written authorization, we will allow a one-time courtesy callback procedure using only a number already on our system. One that you provide at the time of the call cannot be used. No funds will be sent if we are unable to reach you until we receive this completed and signed form back in the mail. **It is very important that you keep us informed of phone and address changes.**

As an added word of caution – DO NOT let anyone overhear your use of the secure password or they can also use it to transfer funds if they know the answers to the other identification questions that we ask. This secure password may be different than the password on your account.

If you no longer want anyone else to transfer funds from your account using these types of funds transfers, you must notify us immediately in writing.
